Certificate III in Individual Support (Home and community)

The Certificate 3 Guarantee program provides Queenslanders with access to government subsidised training places, up to and including their first Certificate III level qualification in priority training areas. Accessing this government funding may reduce your ability to receive further subsidised training in the future. A Certificate III is the first level of post-school qualification shown to have significant impact on a person's employment and earnings. It is also the level of qualification usually required to get a job in the disability and home and community sector.

Assessment: Flexible and competency based. Participants will undertake a combination of classroom activities/written/oral assignments and practical activities.

Student Employment Survey: All students are required to complete a student employment survey within three months of completing or discontinuing the qualification. This will be administered by IMPACT staff.

Vocational Outcome: CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Home and Community).

Eligibility requirements include:

- Have either finished or left secondary school
- 15 years of age or older
- Meets Certificate 3 Guarantee funding eligibility
- Meets SQW funding eligibility (See flyer or Website for details)

Course cost for students eligible for Certificate 3 Guarantee funding:

- \$50 is your student co-contribution cost if you hold a concession card
- \$100 is your student co-contribution cost if you do not hold a concession card
- In addition to the above cost students will be required to purchase a uniform (approximate cost \$30-\$40)

Course cost for students eligible for Skilling Queenslanders for Work (SQW) funding:

SQW will pay all course costs, including uniforms, for students who meet SQW eligibility (ask our friendly staff for details)

Course cost for students ineligible for government funding assistance:

\$3664 is the full course cost (a payment plan may be negotiated if paying the full amount).
